- Each entry must be original work of the entrant and unpublished.
- Each entrant may submit one entry of creative writing per category.
- Each entry must be typed or printed on one side of white letter sized paper.
- Author's name and address must appear in the upper right hand corner of all entries.
- Each entry must be accompanied by a signed entry form.
- If created by computer, submit word processing file on disk with your entry, or attach and email to: ksampson2@winco.net.
- Entries must be received by August 2, 2010 by mail to FCAC, P.O. Box 254, Canton, IL 61520
- The Fulton County Arts Council has the right to reject any piece of work deemed unacceptable.
- The Fulton County Arts Council Board of Directors will determine the number of awards based on the number of entries in each category. Prizes will be awarded in September, 2010.
- Entries may be published by the Fulton County Arts Council.

Entry Categories:

- Fiction . . . Short Stories (maximum length of 700 words)
- Biographical Non-Fiction . . . Short Stories (maximum length of 700 words)
- Poetry (maximum of 24 lines on one page)

Entry Divisions:

- Youth . . . Ages 18 and younger.
- Adult . . . Ages 19 through 64.
- Seniors. . . Ages 65 and older.
